Application Process

Part 1: Application

- A student and their parent/guardian complete the Millennium 6–12 Collegiate Academy application together. Both parties are required to sign the application for admission.

Part 2: Initial Screening

- Completed applications will be reviewed and the application status will be updated within five business days of receipt to reflect if applicant has or has not met initial eligibility requirements.

Part 3: College Admissions Testing

Applicants who meet the initial eligibility requirements will receive a status update requesting that the applicant provide test scores. These applicants may:

- take the Post-Secondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) at Millennium 6 – 12 Collegiate Academy. Only official PERT score reports will be accepted.
- submit SAT or ACT scores that meet admissions requirements by the deadline.

Part 4: Admission Notification and Responses

- Applicants who meet the testing requirements will have their status updated to “qualified applicant.”
- Qualified applicants will be admitted unless the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of available seats. If this occurs a

computerized random selection process will be utilized once the deadline for testing has passed.

- Qualified applicants selected for admission will receive a status updated to “offered admission” and must accept the admission offer within the specified time frame.
- Qualified applicants who are not selected for an *offer of admission* will receive a place on the wait list. Applicants on the waitlist will be offered admission in the order assigned during the random selection process as seats become available.

Part 5: Enrollment Process

- Applicants accept admission by completing a Broward College (BC) application online. Students who have a BC ID number do not need to reapply.
- Once the applicant has a BC ID number the applicant must submit an enrollment form to the Millennium 6 – 12 Collegiate Academy.
- Admitted students will be scheduled for a registration session with the BC and Millennium 6 – 12 Collegiate Academy advisors.
- Admitted students must attend a mandatory registration session in May.
- During registration students will select their Term 1 classes.
- The student performance contract acknowledge must be signed at the registration session.
