Admissions Testing

As part of the admission process for Millennium 6-12 Collegiate Academy, you must take the College's Basic Skills Assessment Test called the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT). The PERT has three sections that you must pass: reading, writing, and math. The PERT is a computer based test which takes approximately 2.5 hours. The PERT is not an easy test, particularly in the math area.

Students who have existing qualifying SAT/ACT/PERT scores do not have to take the PERT. As per Broward College Policy, test scores submitted must not be older than 2 years to be used for admission.
