**Girl's Required Tops**

| Polo, Rugby or Oxford style – long or short sleeve<br><b>T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top.</b> | (Solid) White, Gray, Baby blue, black, Khaki, and school approved Striped Combinations | <b>T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top.</b><br><b>**NO BLACK on BLACK—black shirts can ONLY be worn with khaki or gray bottoms</b> |

| <p><b>ALL SHIRTS <u>MUST</u> HAVE A COLLAR</b><br/>           BLACK SHIRTS CAN ONLY BE WORN WITH GRAY OR KHAKI BOTTOMS. <b>NO BLACK ON BLACK!!!</b></p> <p><b>Shirts should be tucked in at the waist.</b></p> | <p>The bottoms may not have any designs<br/> <b>No jeans (denim) at any time.</b></p> <p><b>NO WHITE BOTTOMS</b></p> | <p>Visible undershirts: baby blue, khaki, black or white (only)</p> <p><b>T-Shirts/ undershirts may not hang beyond or below the uniform shirt</b></p> |

| Jackets/Sweaters   | Shoes   | *School ID                                    |

Cold Weather Consideration: On days where the weather is **below** 55 degrees, students may wear **plain** sweat pants. These pants **MUST** comply with the uniform policy and colors, **black** or **gray** only. Students who wear sweat pants with stripes, designs or colors other than what is listed above, will receive a uniform violation. Also for the cold days, **ONLY** when the temperature is below 55 degrees, **BLACK** or **KHAKI** jeans **ONLY** can be worn. **NO BLUE JEANS.**
