Eligibility Criteria

Application Criteria – Part I: Initial Screening (must meet ALL criteria)

- Must be registered as an 8th grader at Millennium at time of application will receive assignment priority.
- Must have earned a minimum cumulative unweighted 3.0 GPA in all high school courses taken during middle school.
- If seats are available, lottery process will occur for non-Millennium students
- Must have earned High School credit (B or better) or currently enrolled in the following courses or comparable courses
 - English I
 - Algebra I
 - Geometry
 - Biology
 - HOPE
- **Must have record of good attendance and good citizenship**
- **Meet all required courses must be completed prior to fall term**
- **Must have completion of all required courses prior to Fall term**

Application Criteria - Part 2: Testing Requirements

- Must have passing test scores on three sections of the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (P.E.R.T.) or SAT/ACT that will result in placement for College level course work
