Tour Zion National Park

Designated in 1909, Zion is Utah's oldest national park. The park is known for its incredible canyons and spectacular views. Famous hikes including The Narrows, Subway, and Angels Landing attract adventure enthusiasts from around the world. Hiking possibilities are endless. With nearly three million visitors per year, Zion is Utah's most heavily used park. Most park facilities are located in the Zion Canyon area, and it attracts the most visitors.

Meet motor coach and depart for Lake Powell (3 hours)

Lake Powell

The second largest man-made lake in the United States is the playground for Page, Arizona, and nearly three million visitors annually. Lake Powell is 186 miles long and has 1,960 miles of shoreline, which is longer than the entire west coast of the continental United States.

Tour Glen Canyon Dam

The Glen Canyon Dam, built between 1956 and 1966, stands 710' from bedrock and holds back an amazing 26,215,000 acre-feet of water, or 9,000,000,000,000 gallons, when Lake Powell is full.
