**Boy's Uniform Standard Bottoms**

<b><u>Pants</u></b>	<b><u>Shorts</u></b>	<b><u>Clarifications</u></b>
Trouser style/cargo style <b><u>with</u></b> a belt	Any style <b><u>with</u></b> a belt, unless elasticized  <b>Black, Khaki or Gray only</b>	No White Bottoms  <b>(No jeans At ANY Time!)</b>

**Boy's Required Tops**

<b><u>Shirts</u></b>	<b><u>Colors</u></b>	<b><u>Clarifications</u></b>
Polo, Rugby or Oxford style – long or short sleeve	(Solid) White, Gray, Baby blue, black, khaki, and school approved Striped Combinations	(P.E.) T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top. <b>**NO BLACK on BLACK—black shirts can ONLY be worn with khaki or gray bottoms</b>

**Girl's Required Bottoms**

<b><u>Pants</u></b>	<b><u>Shorts, Skirts, and Skorts</u></b>	<b><u>Clarifications</u></b>
Trouser style/cargo style <b><u>with</u></b> a belt	Any style <b><u>with</u></b> a belt, unless elasticized Black, Khaki or Gray only Must comply with the length policy of the Broward County School Board Dress Code	No White Bottoms <b>No jeans (At ANY Time!)</b> <b>No stretch pants</b> <b>No form fitting pants</b>

**Girl's Required Tops**

<b><u>Shirts</u></b>	<b><u>Colors</u></b>	<b><u>Clarifications</u></b>
Polo, Rugby or Oxford style – long or short sleeve <b>T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top.</b>	(Solid) White, Gray, Baby blue, black, Khaki, and school approved Striped Combinations	<b>T-shirts cannot be worn as school uniform top.</b> <b>**NO BLACK on BLACK—black shirts can ONLY be worn with khaki or gray bottoms</b>

Additional Considerations

Shirts	Pants/Shorts	Undershirts
<p><b>ALL SHIRTS <u>MUST</u> HAVE A COLLAR</b>            BLACK SHIRTS CAN ONLY BE WORN WITH GRAY OR KHAKI BOTTOMS. <b>NO BLACK ON BLACK!!!</b></p>	<p>The bottoms may not have any designs  <b>No jeans (denim) at any time.</b>   <b>NO WHITE BOTTOMS</b></p>	<p>Visible undershirts: baby blue, khaki, black or white (only)   <b>T-Shirts/ undershirts may not hang beyond or below the uniform shirt</b></p>

Jackets/Sweaters	Shoes	*School ID
<p><b>MUST open completely in the front</b>            No Hoodies or Pullovers Allowed (if worn, MUST be underneath uniform shirt)</p>	<p>Closed toe, closed heel shoes, at all times  <b>NO SLIDES</b> at any time!</p>	<p>School ID must be worn around the neck</p>

Cold Weather Consideration: On days where the weather is **below** 55 degrees, students may wear **plain** sweat pants. These pants **MUST** comply with the uniform policy and colors, **black** or **gray** only. Students who wear sweat pants with stripes, designs or colors other than what is listed above, will receive a uniform violation. Also for the cold days, **ONLY** when the temperature is below 55 degrees, **BLACK** or **KHAKI** jeans **ONLY** can be worn. **NO BLUE JEANS.**

*\*\*\*Please consider that during a school year there will be a few cold days. Please plan ahead for these days so that everyone is in compliance with the policy at all times\*\*\**
