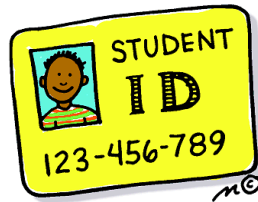


Weight Changes for Fourth Quarter

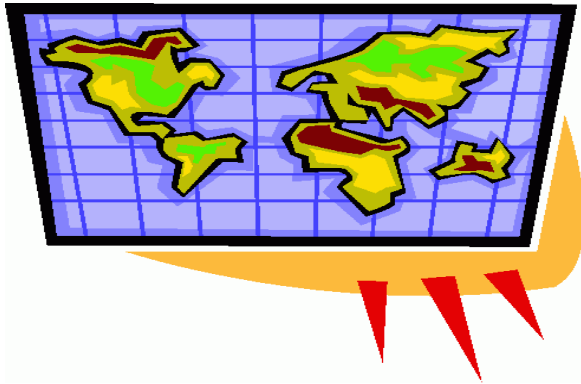
Saturday, May 19, 2018 11:00 a.m. Freshman Family Finale (Close-out of our first year, light refreshments will be provided)

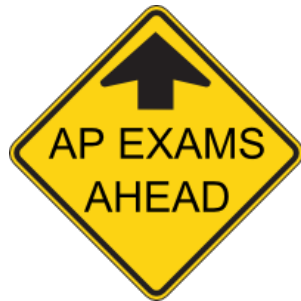
Advanced Placement Human Geography Tutoring
